Digital Citizenship and E-Safety in the Primary Department

All classes (P1-P7) receive an annual lesson in keeping themselves safe online using the **Think U Know** resources developed by Child Exploitation and Online Protection (CEOP) as follows:

- ✓ P1 - P3 Stranger Danger
- ✓ P4 - P7 Issuing Personal Details-Keeping Yourself Safe and Cyberbullying

Pupils in P6 - P7 are taught about e-safety in the Business Education, Computer Science and IT department

- ✓ P6 - 3 lessons on safe searching
- ✓ P7 - 3 lessons "staying safe online" including discussion about chatrooms, social networking sites etc. and how they can protect personal information

Digital Citizenship and E-Safety in the Secondary Department

Pupils are taught about e-safety in the Business Education, Computer Science and IT department

- ✓ S1 - 3 lessons on electronic communication which includes the hazards e.g. phishing, spamming, viruses, flaming as well as Netiquette (Internet Etiquette)

Secondary pupils are also taught about digital citizenship and e-safety in Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE):

4	<p>‘Cyberbullying: Crossing the Line’ – Common Sense Media</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analyse online behaviours that ‘cross the line’ • Learn about the various ways that people can be cyberbullied • What pupils can do about cyberbullying

1	'Exposed' – Think U Know <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing images online (sexting) and consequences • The Law and indecent images
2	Anti-Bullying lessons include discussion of scenarios (Ask.Fm etc) and how to respond
3	'Scams and Schemes' – Common Sense Media <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn how to guard against phishing and identity theft
4	File Sharing – Dos and Don'ts

1	'Trillion Dollar Footprint' – Common Sense Media <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Impact of digital footprint on reputation and image
2	'First to a Million' – Think U Know <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn what to do if they share something they shouldn't have online
