The School

Jordanhill is situated in the West End of Glasgow. It is a combined Primary and Secondary School with a total school roll of approximately 1050, aged from 5 to 18. Primary has 66 pupils per year P1 to P7; Secondary 99 pupils per year S1 to S4 and 195 in S5/S6.

Teaching facilities and resources are excellent. The building housing Modern Languages, mathematics, Social Subjects and Art was completed in 2008, while the adjacent practical buildings housing Science, Home Economics and Design & Technology have all been upgraded. The Primary and remaining Secondary departments are located in the ‘B’ listed north building which has been extensively modernised and upgraded. This includes major refurbishments of the main entrance and school hall (2011-2013), the Learning Zone (2016), Conference Room (2018) and Sixth Year Study facilities (2018).

Sports facilities on campus comprise a full size synthetic hockey pitch, two rugby pitches, two 7-a-side grass football pitches, a multi-user games area, two gyms and a fitness suite (refurbished 2018). The school’s games hall is situated on Anniesland Road, a few minutes walk away. Very extensive sports and outdoor education programmes are offered throughout the school.

Jordanhill has a vibrant music department with an enormous number of groups, ensembles and orchestras. Art too is highly successful with students’ work regularly featuring in national exhibitions.

Jordanhill is the only school in Scotland to hold the **ICT Mark** for excellence in the use of ICT. All teaching areas have interactive whiteboards. In addition to specialist IT suites every department has access to sets of laptops and tablets for flexible deployment. The entire campus is wi-fi enabled and supports bring Your Own Device (BYOD). Office 365 enables learners to access materials in school and at home.

The Swire Chinese Language Centre and a Confucius Classroom opened in August 2016. The Centre offers teaching in Chinese language and culture to pupils in Jordanhill and neighbouring schools.

Admission to S5 or S6

A number of students join Jordanhill at the S5 or S6 stage every year for a variety of curricular or personal reasons. They settle quickly into the School and, as well as enjoying academic success, play an active part in community and leadership roles: in Primary; community programmes; S6 charity committee; Prefects; Captains.



Are there any entry criteria?

We do not select by ability and we do not charge any fees. We will admit you only if we can meet your educational and pastoral needs and do so without detriment to existing students and without incurring additional costs. For example, we will not establish an additional course or class because you wish to join us.

How do I apply?

If you are interested in joining Jordanhill School you should

- Attend for interview with your parent/guardian when invited

You must tell us

- The name of your current school
- The courses you are currently studying and your expected level of performance
- Any additional support needs you have
- The courses you would like to study in S5 and/or S6

If we think we may be able to meet your needs and you wish to continue with your application, we will then contact your current school to confirm the information supplied.

We will not admit you if you are the subject of ongoing disciplinary sanctions by your current school. We also expect you and your parent/guardian to honour any obligations to your current school.
