### CODE OF CONDUCT

- Give a positive effort at all times in training and matches.
- Always listen attentively when the coaches are speaking.

- Be at the appropriate meeting places on time.

- It is our advice that you should always wear safety equipment (e.g. gum shield/shin guards) during all training sessions and games. It is your responsibility to ensure you have the appropriate safety equipment at all times.

Pupils will be selected for matches based on attendance at training, behaviour, attitude and performance. In larger squads, pupils will be rotated but not all players will receive equal playing time, particularly as they progress to senior level.
