## Safety – Refectory Access Road

Please ensure that children do not attempt to take a shortcut by climbing the railings into the north campus playground. The lane to the Refectory is a vehicular route used by service vehicles. It is not for pedestrian access and attempting to climb the fence is dangerous in itself. We have even observed parents doing this!
