**Please note the following points:**

1. Exams will be held in the Assembly Hall and in classrooms noted on the timetable.
2. All exams on the timetable are for N5 level only.
3. During the mock exam diet, pupils will be credited with full attendance unless they are unable to attend a scheduled examination (see below). Pupils are required to attend school only for any exams they are sitting.
4. **If you are unwell on the day of an exam your parent / carer must contact the school by 8.45 am and leave a message for Ms McDade. As with the SQA exams, absence from an exam must be supported with a doctor's certificate. The certificate must be handed in to Ms McDade as soon as possible to allow for an alternative exam time to be arranged for you. Without this information there will not be another opportunity for you to sit the exam missed.**
5. Pupils should report to school at least 10 minutes before the start of each exam and should go to their allocated seat when they arrive. Heads of Department have been asked to advise pupils of their seating allocation in advance of the exam diet via Teams.
6. During the examination diet, pupils must wear school uniform, not sports uniform, at all times when on the school campus. This includes if they are coming into school to meet with a member of staff.
7. Examinees will not be allowed to enter the Refectory early. Primary pupils use the Refectory from 12.05 - 12.40 and Secondary pupils must not enter the Refectory during these times.
8. Pupils who receive additional assessment arrangements during the examination diet will be given details of these by the Support for Learning department. All queries regarding such arrangements should be addressed to Ms Atkinson.

9. Pupils must write their Scottish Candidate Number (SCN) only on their scripts, not their names. Pupils have been issued a laminated card with their SCN on it. They should bring this card with them for every exam so that they can accurately write their SCN on their exam paper
