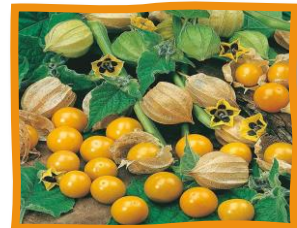
ANNUAL GROWING COMPETITION

Every year, the Eco Committee leaders launch an exciting growing competition inviting children to participate in caring for their own seedlings. Over the years, the seedlings have included tomatoes, chillies and pumpkins. This year, it will be an opportunity to look after **cape gooseberry** seedlings.

The Eco Leaders shared the following information at a recent Assembly-

From Tuesday 28th May, children can take part by bringing in **£1.00** to receive a cape gooseberry seedling. They can plant the seedling in the garden or look after it at home.

- There is a limit of **one seedling per family** and they will be issued on a first come, first served basis.
- Children can enter the competition for the following prizes which will be announced in September-
 - The largest gooseberry
 - The smallest gooseberry
 - The seedling with the highest number of gooseberries
- Children do not bring their plant into school, but are encouraged to take photographs of their plant highlighting its progress. Details to be issued early in the next session.
